Inspect Cables and Connections Ensure the fiber cable is not damaged, bent sharply, or loose. Check the Ethernet cable connecting the fiber box to the router; replace it if frayed or damaged. Confirm the Ethernet cable is plugged into the WAN/Internet port on the router, not a LAN port. Router and Configuration Checks Some routers may fail to obtain an IP address from the fiber box. Rebooting the router can resolve this. Ensure the router firmware is up to date to avoid compatibility issues. If using a fiber-compatible router (e.g., Calix u6), follow the manufacturer's instructions for proper port connections and settings. When to Contact Support If after checking power, cables, and rebooting the devices the internet still does not work, or the fiber box shows a persistent red light, contact your internet service provider.
