□□ Cable cores represent the number of conductors (live wires) within the cable. The selection of number of cable cores basically depends on the type of system where it is going to be installed. A system with some degree of unbalance (or Unbalanced System). These cables are used generally for a perfect. For 4-core cables (3+1 cables) of 1kV and below, the 4th core of them is not only used as a protective ground, but also conveys unbalanced current and short-circuit current in the power system. Its size is determined by unbalanced current and short-circuit current, but generally it should not be. There are mainly two types of optical distribution network (ODN) splitting methods: primary splitting and secondary splitting, as shown in Figure 1. Due to the limitations of PON equipment's optical power and bandwidth, the total split ratio of ODN is generally 1:64 splitter.
