With single-ended grounding, it is usually better to ground the cable shield at the source end, because that is the reference for the signal voltage. Fiber optic cable transmits data as light through glass or plastic strands, which means the fiber core itself carries no electrical current and requires no grounding. Any cable that includes any conductive metal must be properly grounded and bonded in conformance with the. Correct method of grounding optical cable

Choose a suitable grounding point: The optical cable should be grounded as close to the equipment end and/or where the optical cable enters the building as possible.
