- No Internet Service or Misconfiguration:** If the WAN or internet light is off, it could indicate that the router is not receiving an IP address from your ISP or that the service is not active.
- Device Not Connected:** If no devices are connected via Wi-Fi or Ethernet, the corresponding LAN or Wi-Fi lights will remain off.

Troubleshooting Steps

- Check Cables:** Ensure the fiber cable is securely connected to the ONT and the Ethernet cable is firmly connected between the ONT and your router.
- Restart Devices:** Power off both the ONT and router, wait 30 seconds, then power them back on. Wait a few minutes for the lights to stabilize.
- Test Ethernet Cable:** Swap the LAN cable with a known working one to rule out a faulty cable.
- Check ISP Status:** Log in to your ISP account or contact support to confirm there are no outages or service issues in your area.
- Verify Router Settings:** Ensure your router is configured correctly for your ISP's network, especially if it was recently reset or replaced.
