

Optical Cable Parallel Installation Process

Parallel installation of optical cables requires careful planning, proper handling, and adherence to bend radius and pulling guidelines to prevent damage and ensure optimal performance.

Cable Handling Optical fiber is delicate and must be handled with care. Avoid twisting, kinking, or bending below the minimum bend radius, and never pull cables over sharp edges. Use figure-8 loops when laying long cable sections on the ground to prevent twisting, and flip the loops so the pulling end is on top. Protect cable ends from dust and contamination, cleaning connectors before installation.

Parallel Installation Techniques When installing multiple cables in parallel: Maintain separation to prevent excessive mechanical pressure at crossing points. Use plastic clamps with large surface areas to secure cables without crushing the sheath. Avoid placing fiber cables in the same conduit with copper cables to prevent excessive loading or twisting. Apply special cable lubricants if necessary to reduce friction during pulling. Ensure all bends are smooth and gradual, avoiding sharp turns or abrupt direction changes.

Splicing and Termination For each cable in parallel: Leave sufficient cable reserves in the shape of figure-8 or circular loops for future maintenance. Use splice protectors and handle fibers with appropriate stripping tools. Connect fibers using pigtailed or direct connector mounting, and ensure patch cords are cleaned before connection.
