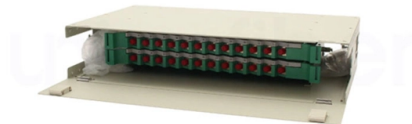


Optical Module Removal Process

Safety Precautions Before removing an optical module, always:

Store Safely: Place the removed module in an anti-static bag to protect it from ESD and contamination.

Install Dust Cover: Insert a dust cover into the empty slot to protect the port from dust and debris.

Optional Tools

- Small flat-head screwdriver: Only needed if the module has a retaining clip that cannot be released by hand.
- Lint-free wipes and fiber cleaning tools: Useful if you plan to clean the optical interfaces before reinsertion.
