- Duplex:** Two fibers, two-way communication, standard for most modern optical modules with separate Tx/Rx ports.

Transmission Distance and Data Rate

- Match the jumper to the module's wavelength and data rate:**
- 850nm:** Short-distance, multimode fiber.
- 1310nm or 1550nm:** Medium to long-distance, single-mode fiber.

Ensure the fiber type supports the required distance and speed to minimize signal loss.

- Identify the optical module's interface type (LC, SC, MPO, etc.).
- Determine the fiber mode based on distance and application (single-mode for long, multimode for short).
- Choose simplex or duplex according to the module's port configuration.
- Select a jacket type (PVC, LSZH, OFNR, OFNP) based on installation environment and fire safety requirements.
- For connecting devices with different port types, use hybrid patch cords (e.g., LC-SC, LC-ST).
