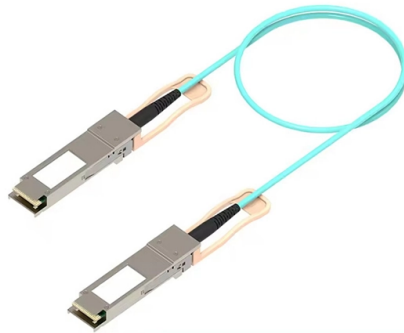


# Optical switches need to be configured with IP addresses

To configure an IP address on an optical switch, assign it to a management VLAN interface, enable the interface, and optionally set a default gateway for network access.

1. Access the Switch CLI Connect to the switch using a serial console cable, SSH, or Telnet. Log in with your credentials. If using default settings, the username and password may be something like cisco/cisco .
2. Enter Privileged EXEC Mode At the CLI prompt, enter enable and provide the enable password to access privileged mode .
3. Enter Global Configuration Mode Use the command configure terminal to enter global configuration mode .
4. Select the Management Interface (VLAN) Most switches use VLAN 1 as the default management VLAN. Enter interface configuration mode with:  
`CodeCopyinterface vlan 1` If your network uses a different VLAN for management, replace 1 with the appropriate VLAN ID .
5. Assign the IP Address and Subnet Mask Set a static IP address with the command:  
`CodeCopyip address` For example:  
`CodeCopyip address 192.168.1.10 255.255.255.0` Optionally, you can also specify a default gateway for the switch to communicate outside its subnet:  
`CodeCopyip default-gateway` For example:  
`CodeCopyip default-gateway 192.168.1.1` This step ensures the switch can be managed remotely across different subnets .
6. Enable the VLAN Interface Activate the interface using:  
`CodeCopyno shutdown` This brings the VLAN interface online so the IP address is active .
7. Save the Configuration Exit interface mode and save the configuration to prevent loss after a reboot:  
`CodeCopyendwrite memory` or  
`CodeCopycopy running-config startup-config` This ensures the IP settings persist .
8. Verify the Configuration Check the IP address assignment and interface status with:  
`CodeCopyshow running-configshow ip interface brief` This confirms the swi...
