Early Development The concept of network cabinets emerged alongside the first server rooms in the 1950s, when enterprises and government institutions began using large, cumbersome computers that required specialized installation and environmental conditions (Lanberg) . Early ICT equipment from companies like IBM, DEC, and HP dominated the market, and the need for organized storage became apparent as these machines were large, heavy, and difficult to maintain (Lanberg) . To address this, the first network cabinets were designed to fit the 19-inch rack standard, which became the industry norm for electronic equipment. These cabinets were typically made of steel or aluminum and allowed for organized mounting of servers, switches, routers, and other devices (NetRackes) . Purpose and Design Network cabinets were developed to maximize space efficiency, improve airflow, and simplify maintenance in server rooms and data centers (Eabel) . The vertical stacking of equipment in racks not only saved floor space but also facilitated cable management and hardware protection. Over time, cabinets evolved to include features such as perforated doors, ventilation panels, and modular accessories to s...
