Ensure proper burial depth (typically 1.5 meters) or conduit protection for underground installations, and secure aerial cables to poles or support structures to prevent sagging or tension.

Handling and Storage Handle cables carefully to maintain the minimum bend radius and avoid twisting or pulling excessively. Store spare cables in a clean, dry environment, and verify their integrity before deployment. Use structured cable management tools such as trays, ties, and managers to reduce tension and prevent microbends or fractures over time.
