- Display & Interface:** Many testers feature a full-color LCD for clear visualization of test results, including PoE status, continuity, and wiring errors.
- Safety & Convenience:** Built-in protection against live voltage up to 60V and rechargeable batteries with USB-C charging for field use.

Practical Use

When troubleshooting PoE issues on switches:

- Verify Port Status:** Use the tester to check if the switch port is delivering power and if the PD is drawing the expected current.
- Check Cabling:** Ensure the Ethernet cable is compliant (Cat5e/Cat6 recommended) and within the 100-meter limit for PoE delivery.
- Identify Faulty Ports or Devices:** The tester can help determine whether the problem lies with the switch, the cable, or the powered device.
- Confirm PoE Standards:** Test whether the switch supports the required PoE standard (af, at,...
