For tower bases, scaffolding or rope access may be used to ensure safety and precision. Some contractors also offer single-coat or two-coat systems, with epoxy primers often followed by a polyurethane topcoat for maximum protection.

Safety and Compliance Safety is critical when working on tower structures. Workers should follow fall protection protocols, wear personal protective equipment (PPE), and adhere to OSHA and NACE standards. For towers marked with red and white FAA colors, maintaining proper paint visibility is also a regulatory requirement.
