Modules in high-density racks or poorly ventilated areas can overheat, accelerating degradation of laser diodes and driver ICs (). QSFP modules, in particular, may run hotter than SFPs due to side-by-side placement. Monitor Digital Optical Monitoring (DOM) parameters such as TX bias, RX power, and module temperature to detect early signs of stress or contamination (). Lifespan and Replacement Short-reach modules in clean, cooled environments typically last five to seven years, while modules in harsher conditions may require replacement every three to five years (). Replace modules proactively based on trend analysis (rising pre-FEC errors, TX bias drift, or RX power decline), environmental stress, or end-of-lifecycle planning ().
