- Monitoring and Management:** Many PoE switches allow remote monitoring, power cycling, and management of individual ports, which is essential for maintaining uptime and troubleshooting devices.

Coordinating Zigbee and Z-Wave Devices over PoE

Modern smart home coordinators, such as the SLZB-06 Zigbee PoE coordinator, leverage PoE to receive both power and data through a single Ethernet connection (). This allows:

- Flexible Placement:** Coordinators can be positioned centrally for optimal radio coverage, independent of server location ().
- Reduced Interference:** Moving coordinators away from USB ports or other electronics minimizes RF interference, improving mesh network stability ().
- Standalone Operation:** PoE coordinators can operate independently of the Home Assistant server, maintaining the mesh network even if the server is offline ().

For multi-protocol setups, such as Zigbee and Z-Wave, it is often necessary to use separate PoE coordinators for each protocol, as combined PoE devices are rare and may not meet all user requirements (). Using a dedicated PoE...
