Typical commercial building installations with 100-200 network drops range from \$15,000 to \$30,000, which includes both horizontal and vertical cabling. Underground or complex installations increase costs due to trenching, conduit, and labor.
- Example Estimate for Eight Horizontal and Eight Vertical Runs** Assuming 100-foot runs per cable, 16 cables total, and an average cable cost of \$2 per foot, material costs alone would be roughly \$3,200. Adding installation, connectors, and patch panels could bring the total to \$5,000-\$10,000 for a standard office setup. For higher-count or armored cables, or more complex installations, costs could exceed \$15,000.
