- Operational Safeguards** Implement regular inspection and maintenance schedules to detect early signs of wear or tampering. Use remote monitoring systems where feasible to track load, voltage, and tampering events. Maintain spare parts and emergency repair kits to restore service quickly after damage.
- Community Engagement** Educate local communities on the importance of protecting electrical infrastructure. Encourage community reporting of theft or damage to reduce vandalism and improve response times.
