They can be flat strips or comb-style bars that connect multiple MCBs simultaneously, improving safety and reducing the risk of loose connections ().

Wiring Layout and Connections

Main Supply Connection: The incoming phase and neutral wires are connected to the main MCB or isolator. The main MCB output is then connected to the copper busbar. In single-phase systems, a double-pole MCB is often used as the main switch ().

Branch Circuit Connections: Branch MCBs are connected to the copper busbar using either: Direct bolted connections with appropriate torque. Comb busbars that clip onto multiple breakers simultaneously for uniform distribution ().

Neutral and Earth Bars: Separate copper strips are used for neutral (N) and earth (PE) connections. All neutral wires from branch circuits connect to the neutral bar, and all protective earth wires connect to the earth bar ().

RCCB Integration: In domestic or single-phase setups, the main MCB output feeds the RCCB, which then distributes power to branch MCBs. Copper strips are used to connect the RCCB output to the branch circuits ().
