- 4. Cleaning Tools** Lint-free wipes and high-purity isopropyl alcohol are used to clean the fiber ends before splicing. Even microscopic dirt can increase splice loss or weaken the joint.
- 5. Protective Sleeves** After splicing, a small protective sleeve is placed over the joint to safeguard it from mechanical stress and environmental factors, ensuring long-term durability.

Additional Equipment and Accessories

- Electrodes:** Tungsten electrodes in the splicer generate the electric arc for fusing fibers.
- Anti-static Equipment:** Wrist straps or mats prevent static electricity from damaging sensitive splicer electronics.
- Power Supply:** Stable battery or AC power is essential for consistent splicing performance.
- V-Grooves and Clamps:** These hold fibers in place during alignment and fusion.
