IP Rating Overview

Material and Construction Considerations

Boxes are often made from 2 mm galvanized steel or stainless steel for durability and corrosion resistance. Doors should have secure locking systems and concealed hinges to prevent tampering and maintain protection. Adequate earthing points are required to ensure electrical safety. Internal layout should provide sufficient clearance for safe maintenance and accommodate bus bars, MCCBs, and lighting circuits.

Testing and Compliance

Distribution boxes must undergo type testing for IP ratings at certified laboratories (e.g., CPRI or NABL-accredited labs) to verify dust and water protection. Compliance with IEC, NEC, and local electrical codes ensures safety, reliability, and regulatory approval. Routine inspections and maintenance are recommended to maintain protection levels over time.
