Structural and Environmental Protection: Primary distribution boxes are often designed with impact-resistant, corrosion-resistant materials and may feature rainproof enclosures for outdoor use. This ensures durability and safety in harsh environments, such as construction sites or industrial areas .

System Organization and Isolation: The box allows for isolation of circuits for maintenance or emergency purposes, following the principle of “one machine, one switch, one RCD, one box, one lock,” which prevents multiple devices from being controlled by a single protective device .
