- Turn off the main power** before opening the panel to prevent electrical shock .
- Check labels:** Each breaker should be clearly marked with the area or device it controls. Update or replace labels if they are missing or hard to read .
- Trace circuits:** Follow the outgoing lines to understand which equipment or room each breaker serves .
- Inspect for safety:** Look for neat wiring, proper grounding, correct wire sizes, and any signs of damage .
- Use protective gear:** Wear insulated gloves and safety glasses when inspecting the box .
- Test if necessary:** If you are trained, use a multimeter to check voltage and ensure...
