International Standards: The ITU-T Recommendation L.163 provides guidance for optical fiber cable installation, particularly in areas with minimal infrastructure. It covers cable-route planning, selection of cable types, installation schemes, tension and temperature considerations, bend protection, and pilot testing. Compliance is voluntary but ensures interoperability and reliability in challenging environments . **European Union Regulations:** In the EU, optical cables are subject to directives such as the Low Voltage Directive (50–1,000 V AC, 75–1,500 V DC) and the Construction Products Regulation, which sets performance requirements for cables used in buildings. Additionally, EU trade regulations, including anti-dumping and anti-subsidy measures, may apply to imported optical fiber cables . **National Telecom Regulations:** Fiber optic network regulations under telecom infrastructure law define licensing, spectrum management, infrastructure sharing, and operational compliance. Operators must follow installation standards, maintain proper documentation, and adhere to safety and maintenance protocols to ensure network integrity and equitable access . **Technical and Operational Best Practices**
