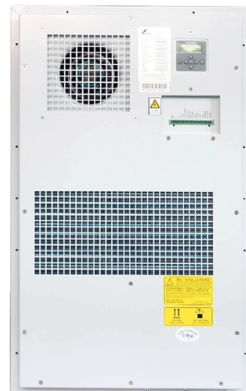

final distribution point, supplying power directly to individual electrical appliances or

household systems. It can be fixed or portable and ensures that each device has its

own circuit breaker and RCD, following the principle of "one machine, one switch, one

RCD, one box, one lock".

Role of a Distribution Box A distribution box can occupy the

secondary or tertiary level in this hierarchy. For example, in construction sites:

A secondary distribution box is installed under the main distribution box to manage

power for a specific area or building.

A tertiary distribution box or switch box is

installed under the secondary box to control individual electrical equipment, forming

the final level of distribution. This structure ensures safe, organized, and hierarchical

power distribution, preventing direct connections that bypass levels and maintaining

proper protection with leakage protectors and circuit breakers.
