

Requirements for Optical Cable Storage and Maintenance

Label and color-code cables systematically to simplify identification, troubleshooting, and future upgrades. Use cable management accessories such as trays, raceways, ties, and patch panels to organize cables and prevent tangling.

Maintenance Practices Regular maintenance ensures optimal performance and prevents network failures: Inspect connectors and cables for visible defects, such as cracks, bent ferrules, or contamination. Clean optical surfaces using clean dry air (CDA), lens tissue, and spectroscopic-grade solvents like methanol, following manufacturer guidelines. Test cables with tools like OTDR (Optical Time-Domain Reflectometer) and visual fault locators to detect signal loss or faults.
