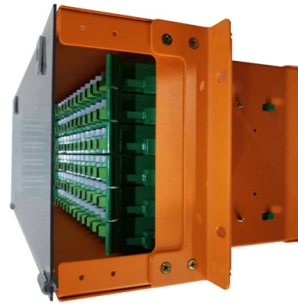


Requirements for electrical distribution boxes at construction sites in Malta

Electrical distribution boxes in Malta must comply with the Electrical Installations Regulations (S.L.545.24) and subsequent amendments, ensuring safety, proper authorisation, and integration with the national distribution system. Technical and Safety Requirements Voltage and Rating: Distribution boxes must be suitable for installations rated at 230/400 Volts (+/-10%), accommodating both single-phase and three-phase systems. For high-demand consumers, boxes must support connections exceeding 60 Amps per phase. Protection Mechanisms: Boxes must include appropriate circuit breakers, surge protection devices, and isolation switches to protect internal wiring and connected equipment. Installations with generators or energy storage systems must have backup equipment that physically disconnects from the distribution system, with anti-islanding protection to prevent unintentional backfeeding. Authorisation and Certification: Only authorised providers licensed by the Regulator for Energy and Water Services (REWS) may design, install, or certify distribution boxes. Providers must hold the appropriate authorisation for single-phase or three-phase installations, depending on the system rating. Signage and Identification: Installations with backup generators or energy storage must display clear signage indicating the presence of...
