

Requirements for the ground surface of construction site electrical distribution boxes

Consistency: Within the same site, maintain uniform installation heights with deviations not exceeding 10 mm.

Proximity to Equipment: Distribution boxes should be installed close to the electrical equipment they serve, with horizontal distances not exceeding 3 meters to reduce line losses.

Proper Grounding: All metal boxes must be grounded using approved methods to prevent electric shock and ensure compliance with safety standards.
