

Rules for installing distribution boxes

Wiring and Internal Layout Before wiring, ensure the power is completely cut off and verify with an electrical tester. Use high-temperature resistant copper wires with cross-sectional areas matching the load current. Maintain neat cable management, proper insulation, and clear wire labeling to facilitate future maintenance. All cable inlets and cover joints should be sealed to prevent dust or moisture ingress. Include circuit breakers, fuses, and surge protectors, with each circuit having its own protection.

Grounding and Safety Protection The metal enclosure, electrical installation board, and internal appliances must be properly grounded. The protective neutral wire should be securely connected through the terminal board. Ensure compliance with NEC, IEC, or local electrical codes, and use UL/CE-certified components. Avoid storing flammable materials inside the box, and maintain clearances to prevent thermal hotspots or fire.
