Clean Connectors: Remove dust caps and inspect connectors to prevent signal loss. Insert SFP Module: Align the keyed notch with the slot on the device and gently insert until it clicks. Connect Cable: Align the fiber or copper connector with the SFP module and insert until secure. Use the lock tab if available. Test Connection: Use a power meter or visual fault locator to verify proper signal transmission. Secure Cables: Prevent accidental disconnection by routing and securing cables properly. Best Practices: Always handle fiber optic cables carefully to avoid bending or damaging the fibers. Use static-free environments when handling SFP modules to prevent electrostatic damage. Match connector types between the SFP module and patch cable to avoid adapters and insertion loss. Stor...
