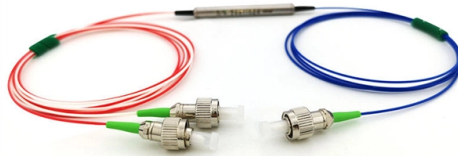


Sample IP Rating of Distribution Boxes

IP ratings consist of two digits after the letters "IP", each with a specific meaning. A higher number means better dust resistance—for example, a rating of 5 means the device keeps out most dust, while 6 indicates.
