- Airflow and cooling:** Deeper racks improve airflow management and reduce hotspots in high-density cloud environments.
- Future expansion:** Choosing a taller rack (42U or higher) allows for additional servers without replacing the rack.
- Weight and load:** Ensure the rack can support heavy UPS units or storage arrays, especially in hyperscale deployments.
- Cable management:** Adequate depth and side clearance are essential for neat cabling and maintenance.
