

Set up the fiber optic router as a wireless network

Step 4: Configure Router Settings Access the router's admin panel via a browser (e.g., 192.168.1.1 or router-specific URL). Enter ISP credentials if required. Select Wireless Router Mode and configure Wi-Fi SSID and password. Enable security features such as WPA3 encryption and consider QoS settings for prioritizing traffic like video calls or streaming.

Step 5: Optimize Network Performance Place the router in a central location to maximize Wi-Fi coverage. Update the router firmware to the latest version. Use dual-band or Wi-Fi 6/6e routers for higher speeds and reduced interference. For larger homes or offices, consider mesh Wi-Fi systems or additional access points connected via fiber or Ethernet.
