

Setting up a wireless router with a fiber optic interface

Use an Ethernet cable to connect the ONT's LAN/Ethernet port to the router's WAN/Internet port. Ensure both devices are near a power source and in a dry, ventilated area. Avoid placing near metal objects or walls that may block Wi-Fi signals.

Step 4: Power On Devices

Power on the ONT first and wait for the status lights to stabilize (usually 2–5 minutes). Power on the router and wait for its indicator lights to confirm a successful connection.

Step 5: Configure Router for Wireless Access

Open a web browser and enter the router's IP address (commonly 192.168.1.1 or 192.168.0.1). Log in using the default credentials provided in the router manual. Set up your Wi-Fi network name (SSID) and password. Enable Quality of Service (QoS) if needed for prioritizing video calls or gaming traffic. Save settings and restart the router if prompted.

Step 6: Optimize Placement and Performance

Place the router centrally in your home for even Wi-Fi coverage. Keep it elevated and away from obstructions. Ensure proper ventilation to prevent overheating. Use a surge protector...
