

Should the distribution box and electricity meter be installed separately

- Regulatory Compliance:** Utility regulations and standards often mandate that only utility-owned equipment be installed in the meter enclosure. Installing additional devices in the meter box can violate regulations and prevent future upgrades or maintenance by the Distribution Network Operator (NICEIC) .

Exceptions: Meter Combos In some residential applications, meter combos integrate the meter socket and main breaker in a single enclosure. These are designed to be code-compliant, space-efficient, and safe, primarily in single-family homes. They combine metering and primary power disconnect functions but still maintain separation internally between the metering and distribution components (ABB Electrification) .

Best Practices

- Meter Box:** Should contain only the meter, incoming supply terminals, and any utility-required isolation devices. Access should be restricted to authorized personnel (NICEIC) .
