The usable distance is often limited to less than 100 meters, even if the single-mode transceiver is rated for kilometers.

Practical Solutions

If you must connect a single-mode cable to a multi-mode module, the recommended approach is to use a mode conditioning patch cable. This type of cable offsets the single-mode launch away from the center of the multi-mode fiber, simulating a typical LED launch and reducing modal dispersion. Mode conditioning cables are duplex patch cords and are designed for 1000BASE-LX single-mode modules over multi-mode fiber. Without them, the single-mode laser light entering the multi-mode core can generate multiple light paths, confusing the receiving module and causing significant signal loss.

Key Considerations

Temporary Use Only: Such connections are suitable for emergency or non-critical links, not for permanent installations.

Avoid Multi-Mode to Single-Mode: Connecting a multi-mode module to single-mode fiber is highly problematic, as most of the light is lost due to the small single-mode core, resulting in almost no data transmission.
