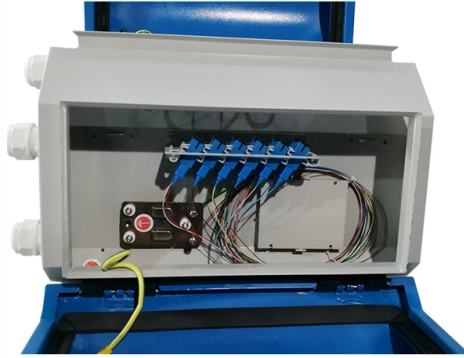


Single-phase cable tray installation
