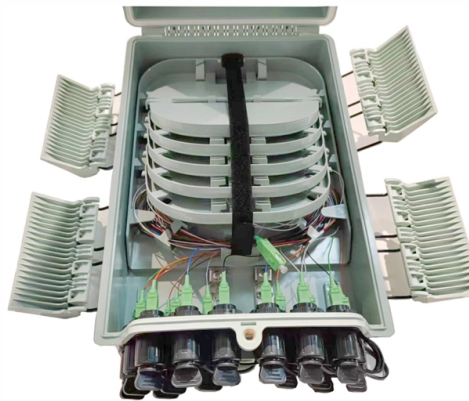


South Asia Core Switch Configuration



AI Overview

Core switches serve as the central hub of a network, aggregating traffic from distribution and access layers, and require careful configuration of VLANs, routing, DHCP, and security for optimal performance.

Core Switch Role and Selection A core switch operates at the core layer of a hierarchical network, handling high-speed data forwarding between distribution switches and the egress router, and connecting to the internet or external networks. Key considerations include:

- High performance and throughput to handle large volumes of traffic.
- Scalability through modular or stackable designs to accommodate future growth.
- Redundancy with dual power supplies and link aggregation to ensure continuous operation.
- Advanced security features such as ACLs and source IP/MAC verification.

Basic Configuration Steps

- Device Access and Management** Log in via console or management interface. Assign a management VLAN (avoid VLAN 1) and configure a management IP for remote access and Telnet/SSH login.
- VLAN and Interface Configuration** Create VLANs for different departments or subnets. Assign VLAN interfaces with IP addresses for inter-VLAN routing. Connect access switches via aggregate links for redundancy and load balancing.
- Routing** Configure static routes or dynamic routing protocols to communicate with the egress router. Set a default route pointing to the egress router for internet access. Ensure inter-department communication by assigning IPs to VLAN interfaces for each subnet.
- DHCP Configuration** Enable DHCP on the core switch to serve IP addresses to connected devices. Configure DHCP pools for each VLAN or department. Implement DHCP snooping on access switches to prevent rogue DHCP servers.
- Security and Traffic Control** Enable IP Source Guard (IPSG) to verify source IP and MAC addresses. Apply ACLs to control traffic between VLANs or to external networks. Use QoS to prioritize critical traffic and maintain performance.
- Redundancy and High Availability** Deploy stackable or HA core switches to ensure failover. Use lin...
