**European Standards:** EN 50600-2-4 and the broader EN 50600-x series define requirements for fixed cabling infrastructures, cross-connect cabinets, equipment row cabinets, and cable management systems in data centers, including availability classes and operational efficiency.

**Installation and Acceptance Requirements**

**Pathways and Frames:** Cable management frames must provide organized pathways for voice, data, video, and control cables, maintaining separation from power lines to reduce interference. Frames should allow for future expansion and modularity, supporting multi-vendor and multi-product environments.

**Bend Radius and Fastening:** Maintain proper bend radius for all cables to prevent signal degradation. Twisted-pair cables must not be tightly bound; slight air space inside sheathing is required to reduce mutual capacitance and data errors.
