They often feature I-beam side rails with welded rungs, rounded edges, and smooth welds to prevent cable damage. Rung spacing is typically up to 102 mm, and trays are engineered to allow top or bottom mounting of cable ties and clamps. Load ratings include a 1.5 safety factor, with additional concentrated load support of up to 200 lb per section.
