Enclosures are made from engineering thermoplastics (PC, ASA) or powder-coated/epoxy-coated steel for durability, UV resistance, and corrosion protection ().

Types Distribution boxes are classified based on installation and application:

- Surface-mounted:** Installed on walls, suitable for retrofits and industrial environments.
- Flush-mounted:** Embedded in walls for aesthetic residential or commercial installations.
- Pole-mounted:** Outdoor use for street lighting or utility applications.
- Single-phase:** Residential or small commercial loads.
- Three-phase:** Industrial or large commercial facilities.
- Lighting, power, or control distribution boxes:** Specialized for lighting circuits, heavy machinery, or control systems ().
