Fastening elements like screws or anchors are generally standardized separately and must ensure a rigid connection. Brackets should not be used as walkways or for personnel support, as this can compromise safety and system integrity.

Electrical and Safety Considerations Cable tray systems, including lifting brackets, often serve as part of the grounding path. Brackets must maintain electrical continuity where required and comply with fire resistance and ventilation requirements to prevent overheating of cables. Proper installation ensures that the tray remains stable under mechanical and environmental stresses.
