Coiling should be limited to 100 ft (30 m) or less, with loops approximately 5–8 ft (1.5–2.4 m) in diameter. Barricades or cones should protect cable on pavement or exposed surfaces to prevent vehicular or pedestrian damage. Trenching and Plowing: Direct burial can be performed via trenching or plowing, with plows being static or vibratory depending on soil conditions. Equipment must provide sufficient drawbar force to penetrate soil without damaging the cable. Vibratory plows reduce required force and equipment size. Depth Requirements: According to general industry standards and the National Electrical Code (NEC), direct-buried fiber optic cables are typically installed at 24–30 inches (60–76 cm) below ground.
