Installation Requirements

Placement: Install in dry, accessible areas with good ventilation, typically at a height of 1–1.8 meters from the floor. For elderly or handicapped users, 1.3 meters is recommended.

Enclosure: Must be non-combustible (metal or fire-resistant plastic) to reduce fire risk, especially in domestic premises.

Protection Devices: Include circuit breakers, residual current devices (RCDs), fuses, and surge protectors. Each circuit should have its own protection.

Wiring: Ensure proper grounding, correct wire gauge, neat cable management, and secure connections. Consider bending radius for larger wires ($>10 \text{ mm}^2$) and allow space for terminal connections.

Accessibility: Panels must be readily accessible for operation, maintenance, and inspection.

Sizing and Layout

Small Loads / Lighting Circuits: Width = sum of switch widths + 20 mm per side; Height = switch height + 40 mm; Depth = max switch depth + 10 mm.

More than 20 Switches: Use two rows; width = sum of switch widths + 40 mm; height = switch height + 40 mm; depth = max switch dept...
