These knockouts can be removed to accommodate different cable sizes, and internal or external clamps secure the cables, preventing strain on the connections. Properly designed knockouts and clamps ensure that wires remain protected from mechanical stress and environmental exposure.

Mounting and Accessibility Junction boxes are designed with mounting holes or flanges to attach securely to studs, joists, or walls. This ensures the box remains flush with the surface and stable during use. Accessibility is a key structural feature: covers can be easily removed for maintenance, upgrades, or inspections, and high-quality fasteners and gaskets maintain safety and environmental protection.

Internal Volume and Layout The internal volume of a junction box is critical for safety and code compliance. Adequate space prevents overcrowding of wires, reduces heat buildup, and allows for proper splicing and grounding. Boxes are sized according to the number of devices (gangs) and the expected wire count, with deeper boxes used for GFCIs, dimmers, or smart devices. Industrial boxes may include additional space for future expansion or complex wiring layouts.
