

Surge protector connected to switch

Network Switch Protection For network switches, especially fixed or rack-mounted switches, surge protectors should be installed on the network interfaces. Connect the IN terminals of the surge protector to the incoming network cables and the OUT terminals to the switch ports. Grounding is critical: the surge protector and switch ground cables should be connected to a common ground bar, ideally with cable lengths between 15–40 cm for optimal protection. If the switch is outdoors or connected via long aerial power lines, a power supply surge protector should also be installed in the network box to prevent damage from lightning or transient surges.

Electrical Switch or Panel Protection For electrical switches or panels, surge protectors can be connected in different ways depending on the type:

- Whole-house surge protectors** are installed at the main electrical panel and may require a dedicated breaker connection to protect all downstream circuits.
- Panel-mounted surge protectors** can connect to existing breakers or bus bars to protect specific circuits, but the wiring must match the surge protector's amperage requirements (typically 12 AWG for 20-amp circuits or 14 AWG for 15-amp circuits).

Type 1 SPDs are installed on the utility side of the main breaker for maximum protection, while **Type 2 SPDs** are installed on the load side, often connecting to existing breakers.

Surge Protector Usage Tips Ensure the surge protector is rated for the voltage and current of the switch or circuit it protects. Avoid daisy-chaining surge protectors or plugging them into UPS units unless specifically designed for that purpose, as this can overload the device and reduce protection. The on/off switch on a surge protector only controls power flow; it does not completely isolate devices from surges, so proper grounding and surge rating are still necessary.
