

Suspended Wall Fiber Optic Cable Installation

Outdoor cables often have a strength rating of at least 2700 N, but residual tension should remain below the manufacturer's long-term load limit.

Separation from power cables: Maintain proper distance from electrical lines to prevent interference and comply with safety standards.

Wall-Mounted Support Enclosures: Use a wall-mounted fiber enclosure to protect and organize cables. Select an enclosure that accommodates the number of fibers and allows for future expansion.

Cable management: Employ J-hooks, trays, or routing guides to support suspended cables along walls or ceilings. Secure cables at regular intervals to prevent sagging and reduce stress on the fiber.

Vertical installations: Clamp cables frequently to prevent the weight from exceeding the maximum recommended load. Start installation from the top to simplify pulling and reduce strain.
