Swissgrid

The Swiss transmission grid, 6,700 km (4,200 mi) in length, operates at voltages of 220 kilovolts and 380 kilovolts and a frequency of 50 Hz. It has 145 switching substations and 12,000 electricity pylons.

Frequency

It connects metering stations throughout Europe: from Portugal to Turkey and from Denmark to Sicily. Devices in the relevant substations at multiple locations in Europe measure the grid frequencies at
