Fiber ports can use either single-mode or multimode fiber, enabling connections over distances ranging from hundreds of meters to several kilometers. Fiber optic switches are essential in data centers, telecom networks, and industrial environments, providing low latency, high reliability, and immunity to electromagnetic interference.
