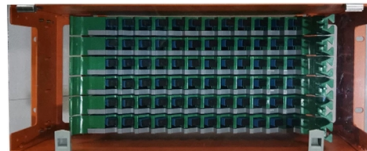


Taiwan Optical Cable Piles



Overview
