Subject-Focused Teacher Networks Networks like the National Writing Project and Bread Loaf Rural Teacher Network focus on developing teachers' content knowledge and pedagogical skills. They often include summer initiation programs, peer critique, and collaborative lesson planning, fostering professional risk-taking and reflective practice.
