Aerial fiber is cheaper to install but more prone to weather-related failures, requiring more frequent repairs and earlier replacement.

Fiber Type: Single-mode fiber (SMF) is ideal for long-distance telecom connections and generally has lower maintenance due to fewer reflections and signal losses. Multi-mode fibers (OM3, OM4, OM5) are common in data centers for short distances and high throughput. OM4 and OM5 support higher speeds and longer distances, which can reduce the need for frequent upgrades.

Repair Complexity: Costs increase with fault location, number of splices, and access challenges. Urban areas may incur higher costs due to traffic control, permits, and right-of-way issues. Typical repair scenarios include 1–2 splices over 1,000–2,000 ft for minor faults or 5–8 splic...
